**AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 23-8 OF THE EXISTING VILLAGE OF
NEW HAVEN STANDING COMMITTEES ORDINANCE NO. 7,
INTENDED TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF FIRE DEPARTMENT
COMMITTEE MEMBERS FROM TWO TO THREE MEMBERS**


THE VILLAGE OF NEW HAVEN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

AMENDMENT TO SECTION 23-8 FIRE DEPARTMENT COMMITTEE:

Section 23-8 shall now read as follows:

The President shall appoint a Fire Department Committee to consist of three members, whose duty it shall be to examine into and report upon all matters referred to them, and to confer with and aid the Chief of the Fire Department in the performance of the duties required of him by law.

EXISTING SECTION 23-8 OF ORDINANCE NO. 7 (CODIFIED AS PART I, CHAPTER 23, ARTICLE I, SECTION 23-8 OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW HAVEN CODE) IS HEREBY REPEALED. THIS AMENDMENT SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PUBLICATION. ANY ORDINANCE OR PART OF ANY ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE AMENDMENT IS REPEALED TO THE EXTENT OF THE CONFLICT.


